Worship Arts Study Update 5: How and why are we able to contemplate increased staff costs when our operating budget has been running at a deficit? This issue is of serious concern to the Worship Arts Vision Team, the Staff Parish Relations Committee, and the Finance Ministry Team. We endeavor to contemplate this effort because we are convinced it is the intervention now needed in the life of Faith Church to rekindle the kind of vision and zeal that has marked this congregation's ministry since its inception. However, instead of focusing on facilities development for ministry, we are now focusing on addressing the heart-felt need of persons to encounter God in ways that speak to their particular way of knowing God. We understand the risky nature of this enterprise. We are intending to "seed" this effort initially by seeking grants from a bequest given to the church and grants from other agencies. We intend to seek the support of the congregation for additional giving to support this vision in the years 2015 and beyond. We are trusting in a belief that this is God's vision for Faith Church and that over time the vision will bear fruit and provide for its own sustenance.
