The evening consisted of an orientation to the genesis of the Vision, the process that has been followed and the anticipated movement forward. Participants then voiced questions at their tables, those questions were grouped as to similar content and then addressed by members of the Worship Arts Team. Due to time constraints not all questions were addressed. The Worship Arts team plans to address unanswered questions through bulletin and newsletter updates. Ongoing conversation is desired.
